Service activities

74 Balwadies functioning in souther six districts in Tamilnadu and 1861 children are getting cultural education with morning malt drink, noon meal and evening snacks.

Mathru pooja celebrated in 11 places in Thoothukudi & Ramnad districts, 230 people participated.

Under 'Adopt a Granny scheme', 27 destitutes and old people were provided with monthly solatiums, in the form of rice, dhal,oil,etc., for their livelihood and 128 persons were provided rice only in six Southern districts of Tamilnadu.

5 tailoring units are functioning well in Nellai & Tenkasi districts with the total attendance of 233.

In 2023 February four eye camps were conducted in Kanyakumari, Tirunelveli & Thoothukudi districts, 451 persons were treated for their eye ailments and 98 persons underwent for cataract operation. 16 persons were given eye medicines.

In our Medicare Programme, 2530 patients were examined and treated for various common ailments by Allopathy medicines in 14 Rural Medical Centers in Kanyakumari, Nellai and Thoothukudi districts. In Ilanji- near Tenkasi weekly once Siddha camp conducted and Siddha medicine only given to the patients and its good effect 142 patients benifitted.

Cultural activities

Monthly Deepa Poojas were organized in 173 village temples in six districts of Southern Tamilnadu, in which 6696 ladies participated and offered prayers for the welfare of the self, family and the society.

Ananthalaya - Vallioor

Ananthalaya conducted in 17 places of southern six districts and 636 students are getting daily education with weekly once Cultural class.

In 175 Sanskara Vargas, 4948 students participated. students were taught about the values of indian culture through games, songs & lessons. The feelings of oneness were strengthened among the participants, through patriotic songs and games.



Vivekavani Subscriptions 144, two years three, three years 14 and 38 Patron were collected.

Under Amrita Surabhi Scheme, collected 508 Kgs of rice from Southern six districts.








Yoga Varga conducted in Kovilpatti and Aruppukottai 28 persons attended.
